Report on Visit to Goonj NGO

Date of Visit: 4th November 2025 **Venue:** Goonj, Sarita Vihar, New Delhi

As part of the school's community outreach initiative, the students of **Suncity School**, **International Academia** visited **Goonj NGO** on **4th November 2025**. The visit aimed to sensitize students towards social responsibility and sustainable living through hands-on learning experiences.

Prior to the visit, the school organized a **donation drive**, during which students collected and contributed usable clothes, toys, stationery, footwear, and bags. These items were handed over to Goonj as part of the visit.

At the Goonj centre, the students were welcomed by the NGO team and given an orientation about Goonj's initiatives such as "Cloth for Work" and "Not Just a Piece of Cloth."
