EDUCATIONAL TRIPS

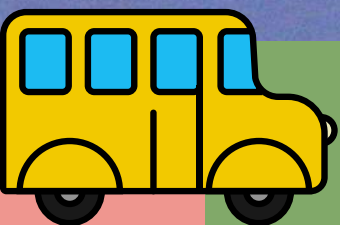

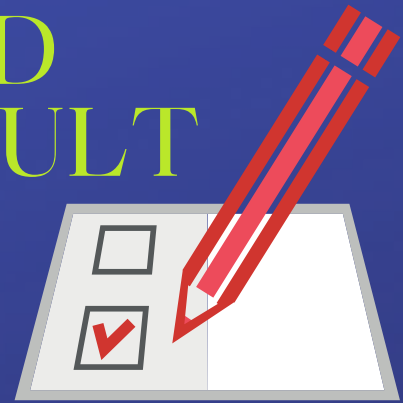
SPECIAL DAYS
